EMERGENCY SERVICES EQUIPMENT LIST

****Items highlighted are minimum required for Trainees****

24 HOUR PACK

24-hour pack should be preferably red or orange webbed gear, or other SAR/Survival Vest acceptable

ON YOUR PERSON:

- Complete ABU uniform
- ABU cap
 - The BDU cap may be replaced by a hard hat or bright colored cap based on mission needs.
- Notepad
- Pencil
- All CAP Identification:
- Membership card
- First Aid card, etc.
- 101 card
- Watch
- Vest, - reflective, orange
- Pocket or utility-type knife
 - multipurpose with can opener.
 - Swiss Army knives, Leatherman, or Gerber Tools are recommended
- Handkerchief or Tissues
- Ground Team Member's Handbook
- Signal Mirror
- Whistle

IN YOUR PACK:

First Aid Kit: - stored in zip-lock bag or another waterproof container, recommended that it consists of the following:

- Any personal medication
 - your team leader should know what you have and where you carry it
- 2 Antiseptic cleansing pads
- Antiseptic ointment
- 6 Band-Aids, various sizes
- Moleskin, 2" X 4"
- Roller bandage
- 2 Safety pins, large
- 4 gauze pads
- 1 Triangular Bandage
- Tape, first aid

- Rubber surgical gloves
 - two pair minimum

Survival Kit: - stored in zip-lock bag or another waterproof container, consisting of:

- 1 Chemical Light Stick, Green
- 12 wooden, waterproofed matches
- Match container, waterproof, with striking surface
- 50' of nylon line (paracord or similar line)
- Duct tape, 5-10 feet
 - does not need to be a whole roll.
- Leaf bag, large

SAR Equipment: stored in zip-lock bags, consisting of:

- Change of socks
- Spare flashlight (penlight will do)
- Tissue Paper
- Work Gloves, leather
- Change for phone calls,
 - or cellular phone
 - to call mission base
- Flagging Tape, 1 roll
- Flashlight (with red or blue lens)
- Spare bulb
- Spare batteries
- Insect repellent
- Lip balm, with sunscreen
- Sunscreen lotion
- Interviewing Form(s), blank
- 4 Moist Towelettes, clean, in foil wrapper
- 2 meals
- Poncho
- Shelter Material, preferably 8' X 10'
 - spare military poncho meets the need
- Coat for current weather,
 - if necessary (in pack if not wearing it)
- Canteen(s) to carry 2 quarts of water
 - At least one quart of water must be carried by all personnel)
- Compass: lensatic or orienteering (orienteering preferred)
 - Compass Pouch, containing.
 - Compass should have a "glow in the dark" dial

UDF Pack

- Complete uniform appropriate to the environment in which you will be working
- Notepad and pencil
- All CAP Identification:
- First Aid card, etc.
- 101 card
- Watch
- Vest, reflective, orange
- Ground and UDF Team Task Guide
- Change for phone calls, or cellular phone
- One Meal or personal funds to purchase a meal while prosecuting the mission, if appropriate
- Handkerchief or Tissues
- Flashlight (with red or blue lens)
- Spare bulb
- Spare batteries
- Compass: lensatic or orienteering (orienteering preferred)
- Compass Pouch, containing
- Compass should have a “glow in the dark” dial
- Protractor used for map work
- Map Case (Large Zip-Lock bags can be used if necessary)
- Pencil, with eraser (plus sharpener if not a mechanical pencil)
- Alcohol Pens, fine tip, at least 2 colors
 - neither the color of your colored flashlight lens
- Eraser for alcohol pens marks
 - such as alcohol swabs or a special alcohol pen eraser.
- A straightedge ruler,
 - at least 6” long
 - Some protractors may have a ruler as well
