Create an account in eServices

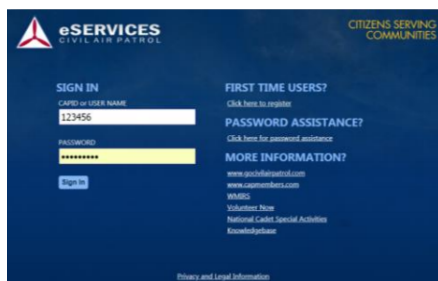
NOTE: This is an account for the cadet to access, not the parents.

The cadet needs to know the username and password. eServices is required for cadets to take tests, apply for some activities, check qualifications, as well other tools.

- **Must have completed Cadet Application and application must have been approved by the squadron commander.**
- **Have a valid email address.**
- Find your CAPID number on your CAPID Card. If you haven't received your card yet, call 1-877-227-9142 and press "1" for help.
 - Should also be in the email you received when your application was approved.
- Know the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.
- Visit [caphq.gov](https://www.caphq.gov), click "Click here to register" under FIRST TIME USERS? and follow the on-screen prompts to create and activate your account.
- After activating your account, please verify your contact information in eServices by clicking "Review/Edit My Info".

How do I know what I need to promote?

1. Everyone can check their own promotion record in eServices by:
 - Login to eServices <https://www.caphq.gov/signin/signin.aspx> or Google CAP eServices.



- Click on the menu icon on the left-hand side of the page.
- Click on Cadet Promotions Track Report.



- A file will download for you to open and view your progress.

- o The last achievement/award on the report is the rank you are currently working towards.

- o The cadet only needs to date when this was completed themselves on the promotion checklist.

 - o Hover your mouse over the menu icon on the left hand side of the page.
 - Go to *Menu\Online Learning\Learning Management System*
 - Click on *Go to AXIS* icon in the upper left hand corner.

- Click on the *Cadet Honor Credit* tab.
You will not be able to take the test until you have completed the interactive module.
- Scroll down to see the courses and click on *Enroll* on the module you want to take.
- Select desired Module
 - Leadership Tests
 - You will only see 1 test available for you, as you progress through them in order.
 - Aero Dimension Tests – Achievements 1-8
 - You can select any module to test in.
 - You may see multiple editions, select the edition you are currently working in, should be Ed 3.
 - Journey of Flight – Achievements 9 – 16

o **Notes:**

- For online, at home tests, the tests **are open book**. Cadets can use the textbook or online book to help them. **You can use CTRL-F, when using the online book.**
- As the **tests are timed**, you still should review the material prior to taking the test to be prepared. Otherwise you may take longer than the allowed time.

• **Proctored tests (Milestone Tests)**

- o Cadets must have the senior member that proctored the test, date and sign the promotion checklist once passed.
- o Are **closed book and timed**, so make sure you are studying along the way and prior to testing.
- o **When can I take a Proctored test?**
 - o Proctored tests are given before regular CAP meetings beginning at 5:30p or during PT nights after PT Testing.
- o **Cadet Responsibilities:**
 - o Proctored tests must be requested online by the Thursday evening prior to Monday's meeting.

 - If we cannot accommodate you for any reason, you receive an email advising so.

How to sign up for Drill tests, oath, speeches, PRB's, SDA's

- **You MUST sign up the THURSDAY prior to the Monday you want to test.**
 - o The general monthly schedule is also posted on this page.
 - o Note: If it's the 1st Monday of the month and a PT night, you cannot drill test for example.
- The link to sign up can be found in multiple places.
 - o There is a link on every weekly announcement, just under the night's schedule and above the announcements.

Active participation in outside activities

- **Cadets must attend at least 1 outside activity each quarter (every 3 months)**
 - o There are generally enough squadron or wing activities to make this happen.
- One of CAP's Core Values:
 - o **Volunteer Service** - "Selflessness" It's the difference between "giving" and "taking."
- Watch the weekly announcements and emails from the group or wing, for additional activities.
 - o NOTE: outside activities are not always sent to the senior members and only to cadets. If you participate in an activity hosted by the group or wing, please email letting me know what you are attending.

- This is a MANDATORY activity for all members.
 - o This is payment to the facility for allowing us to use the facility.
 - o Squadron Workday occurs once a quarter.
